Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Basic White	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper	card front	5 ½" x 4"
Vellum Specialty Paper	big arch	4" x 3"
Basic White	greeting, small arch	3" x 2 ³ / ₄ "
Thread	bow	6"

Instructions

- 1. Fold the Basic White cardstock on the score line to form the card base.
- 2. Attach the Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper (Secret Sea with white branches) to the front of the card.
- 3. Use the Wink of Stella Brush to colour over the branches on the Designer Series Paper, adding a slight shimmer all over.
- 4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut an arch from the small piece of Basic White cardstock using the third from the smallest arch die.

- 5. Stamp "with deepest sympathy" from the Peace of Earth stamp set on the die-cut arch with Secret Sea ink.
- 6. Place the die cut on the card so that the curved part of the arch is to the right and stamp at the curved end of the arch shape.
- 7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut from the vellum:
 - a. One arch (4th from the smallest)
 - b. Two large branches from the Peace on Earth die set
- 8. Attach the white arch to the vellum arch.
- 9. Cut the vellum branches in half (only using the top half) and stick them together in an X sort of shape.
- Attach the branches the white arch to the left of the greeting.
- 11. Tie a bow with some Linen Thread and stick it to the middle of the vellum branches.
- 12. Attach the vellum arch to the card front, approx. ½" from the bottom and so that the small straight edge of the white arch lines up with the folded edge of the card. Trim the excess vellum off.
- 13. Use three small white flowers from the Hues of Blue Flowers to embellish around the greeting.
