## Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Basic White	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Misty Moonlight	first layer	5 ¼" x 4"
Homemade Sweetness Designer Series Paper	second layer	5 ¼" x 4"
Strawberry Slush	mat, circle	3" x 3"
Misty Moonlight	mat, circle	2" x 2"
Basic White	greeting	2 ¾" x 1"
Basic White	berries	3" x 3"
Ribbon	bow	4"

## Instructions

1. Fold the Peach Pie cardstock on the score line to create the card base.
2. Attach the 5 ¼" x 4" Misty Moonlight card stock to the card front at an angle.
3. Attach the Designer Series Paper to the Misty Moonlight on the front of the card at an angle.
4. Flip the card over and use scissors to trim off the excess cardstock and Designer Series Paper.
5. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the circle from the Strawberry Slush cardstock using the second largest Stylish Shapes circle die.
6. Use the 1 ⅞" Circle Punch to punch out a circle from the Punch a circle from the 2" x 2" piece of Misty Moonlight cardstock.

7. Attach the two circles together.
8. Attach the circles to the bottom right of the card front.
9. Stamp the greeting on the 2" x 2" piece of Basic White cardstock with Misty Moonlight ink.
10. Fold the ribbon in half and attach it to the back of the greeting.
11. Attach the greeting/ribbon across the centre of the circles on the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Stamp a strawberry and a blueberry on the 3" x 3" piece of Basic White cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
13. Colour the strawberry using a Blending Brush with the Strawberry Slush ink.
14. Colour the blueberry using a Blending Brush with the Misty Moonlight ink.
15. Colour the leaves with the Old Olive Stampin' Blends markers.
16. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut the berries using the coordinating dies from the Filled with Sweetness dies.
17. Attach the berries to the left side of the greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals.
18. Add a strawberry embellishment to the greeting.
