Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Pretty Peacock	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Granny Apple Green	first layer	5 ¼" x 4"
Valley in Bloom Designer Series Paper	second layer	5" x 3 ¾"
Pretty Peacock	grid and greeting	5 ¼" x 1 ½"
Garden Green	leaves	3 ¼" x 2"
Granny Apple Green	stems	5" x 3 ½"
Basic White	flowers	3 ½" x 3 ¼"
Thread	bow	12"

Instructions

1. Fold the Pretty Peacock cardstock on the score lines to form the card front and back.
2. Attach the 5 ¼" x 4" piece of Granny Apple cardstock to the centre of the card front.
3. Attach the 5" x 3 ¾" piece of Designer Series Paper to the centre of the card front.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the lattice from the 3 ¼" x 2" piece of Pretty Peacock using the Lily of the Valley Dies.
5. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out two embossed leaves from the Garden Green cardstock using the Lily of the Valley Dies.
6. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out three stems from the 5" x 3 ½" piece of Granny Apple Green cardstock using the Lily of the Valley Dies.

7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the flowers from the 3 ½" x 3 ¼" piece of Basic White cardstock using the Lily of the Valley Dies.
8. Attach the die-cut White blooms over the Granny Apple Green flowers with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
9. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to attach all the die-cut pieces. Position the lattice to the middle of the card. Attach the leaves to the right of the lattice, overlapping slightly. Attach the stems/flowers.
10. Stamp the greeting on the leftover piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock with VersaMark ink. Sprinkle White Embossing Powder over the stamped greeting and shake off the excess. Heat the powder with the Heat Tool until smooth and shiny.
11. Use scissors to trim around the greeting.
12. Tie the white Baker's Twine into a double bow.
13. Attach the Baker's twine to the back of the greeting.
14. Attach the greeting to the bottom third of the card on the left side, using Stampin Dimensionals.
15. Add three Shimmering Dots around the flowers.
