# Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Pool Party	card base	11" x 4 ¼", scored at 5 ½"
Beautiful Ordinary Life Designer Series Paper	first layer	5 ¼" x 4"
Beautiful Ordinary Life Designer Series Paper	second layer	5 ¼" x 2 ½"
Beautiful Ordinary Life Designer Series Paper	large balloon	4" x 3"
Beautiful Ordinary Life Designer Series Paper	small balloon	3 ½" x 2 ½"
Daffodil Delight	balloon strings	6" x 1"
Basic White	greeting	3" x ¾"
Basic White	inside	5 ¼" x 4"

# Instructions

1. Fold the Pool Party cardstock on the score line to create the card base.
2. Attach the 5 ¼ x 2 ½" piece of Designer Series paper (second layer) to the 5 ¼" x 4" piece of Designer Series Paper (first layer). Don't attach it to the front of the card yet.
3. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the large balloon from the 4" x 3" piece of Designer Series Paper using the fourth smallest balloon from the Balloon Festoon Dies.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the small balloon from the 3 ½" x 2 ½" piece of Designer Series Paper using the third smallest balloon from the Balloon Festoon Dies.

5. Attach the large balloon to the middle and left side of the front of the card. **Note that the balloon can slightly hang over the left edge of the Designer Series Paper.**
6. Attach the small balloon to the middle and right side of the front of the card. **Note that the balloon can slightly hang over the right edge of the Designer Series Paper.**
7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut two balloon strings from the Daffodil Delight cardstock using the Balloon Festoon Dies.
8. Attach the Daffodil Delight (strings) to the balloons using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
9. Use scissors to cut off the excess strings.
10. Attach the decorated layers to the front of the card.
11. Stamp the greeting towards the left edge of the 3" x ¾" strip of Basic White cardstock with Pool Party ink.
12. Use scissors to cut a banner notch into the end of the greeting strip.
13. Attach the greeting strip to the middle of the card, lined up with the left edge of the card, with Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Attach three yellow Array of Dots to the front of the card.
15. For the inside of the card, stamp a balloon and string on the 5 ¼" x 4" piece of Basic White with Pool Party ink
16. Attach the stamped Basic White cardstock to the inside of the card.
