Measurements

Pretty in Pink	bag topper	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Granny Apple Green	first layer	5" x 4"
Basic White	second layer	5" x 4"
All Season Velvet Specialty Paper	sheep	3" x 2"
Pretty in Pink	greeting & bow	scrap
Smoky Slate	bell	scrap
Garden Green Chevron Ribbon	bow	14"
Bubble Bath Faux Linen Ribbon	bow	14"

Instructions


1. Fold the Pretty in Pink cardstock on the score lines to form the bag topper (looks like a card right now!)
2. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a banner from the folded Pretty in Pink cardstock with the largest Party Banner die. Make sure the die's points are on the open end of the card. Also, make sure the flat end of the die is past the fold on the card (so you don't actually cut the folded part off). Use the points on the open end of the card using the largest Party Banner die.
3. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a banner from the Granny Apple Green card stock using the third largest die.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a banner from the Basic White cardstock using the fourth largest die.

5. Stamp a lamb head on the leftover piece of Basic White cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
6. Use the punch to punch out the stamped lamb's head.
7. Stamp tulips along the bottom edge of the bag front with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
8. Stamp the inside of the tulips with Pretty in Pink ink.
9. Stamp the leaves of the tulips and the grass with Granny Apple Green ink.



10. Stamp the jumping lamb body and butterflies on the front of the bag with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
11. Stamp the bell on the scrap piece of Smoky Slate cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
12. Use the punch to punch out the stamped bell.

13. Attached the punched-out bell to the bottom of the lamb's head.
14. Add the punched-out lamb head to the jumping body with Stampin' Dimensionals.
15. On the die-cut Basic White banner, use a Blending Brush to add Granny Apple Green ink up to the centre.
16. Stamp the trio of tulips on the left side of the banner, about where the green ends, with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
17. Stamp the inside of the tulips with Pretty in Pink ink.
18. Stamp the leaves of the tulips and the grass with Granny Apple Green ink.
19. Lay the folded Pretty in Pink banner at the top of the bag and mark on each side of the handles as shown. Snip on marks (about 1/8" down), then line up the folded edge along the grey edge of the cutting track to cut between snips. This piece will fold over the top of the bag, with the handles passing through the slot!



20. Attach the Granny Apple Green and stamped Basic White banners to the front of the Pretty in Pink banner.
21. Trim any excess off the top of the banner to match the Pretty in Pink banner.
22. Stamp the greeting on one end of the Pretty in Pink strip with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
23. Use the scissors to cut a flag banner into the right end of the greeting.
24. Stamp the lamb head on the white Velvet paper with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
25. Use the punch to punch out the stamped lamb's head.
26. Stamp the lamb body on the White Velvet paper with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
27. Use the punch to punch out the stamped lamb's body.
28. Stamp the bow on the left over Pretty in Pink cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
29. Use the punch to punch out the stamped bow.
30. Attach the bow to the lamb's head.
31. Attach the lamb's body and head to the right-side of the banner with Stampin' Dimensionals.
32. Tie both ribbons around one of the handles.
