

## Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Blackberry Bliss	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Cute as a Bug Designer Series Paper (berries pattern)	first layer	5 ¼" x 4"
Blackberry Bliss	panel for greeting	4" x 2 ½"
Very Vanilla	mat for letters	2 ½" x 1 ¼"
Blackberry Bliss	die-cut letters	4" x 1"
Cute as a Bug Designer Series Paper	banner	scrap
Ribbon	5 ½" for top and 5 ½" for bottom	11"

## Instructions

1. Fold the Berry Burst cardstock on the score line to create the card base.
2. With the "so happy for you" from the Fragrant Blossoms set, stamp ONLY the "so" near the top left corner of the Blackberry Bliss strip with VersaMark ink. Clean the stamp and stamp ONLY the "happy for you" near the bottom left corner of the Blackberry Bliss strip.
3. Sprinkle the stamped greetings with Gold Embossing Powder. Heat the embossing powder with the Heat Tool until it turns gold and shiny.
4. Attach a 5 ½" piece of Old Olive Rickrack to the back of the Blackberry Bliss strip so that just a scallop edge shows. Do this for both the top and bottom edges of the Blackberry Bliss strip.

5. Glue the Blackberry Bliss strip approximately one inch from the top of the Designer Series Paper, then stick the ends of the Rickrack to the back of the DSP.
6. Attach the Designer Series paper to the front of the card, about 1.5 inches from the top.
7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut out the letters for the word "Berry" from the 4" x 1" piece of Blackberry Bliss cardstock using the Mini Alphabet dies.
8. Attach the die-cut letters onto the 2 ½" x 1 ¼" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock.
9. Use scissors to cut around the letters, leaving a border.
10. Punch a banner from a scrap piece of the Designer Series Paper using the Three Banner Punch.
11. Use scissors to cut the banner in half.
12. Attach one end of the banner sticking out from the B and the other end of the banner sticking out from the Y of the BERRY.
13. Attach the word BERRY, at a bit of an angle, between the "so" and "happy for you" on the Blackberry Bliss strip with Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Attach three Iridescent Foil Gems to the greeting (one by the B and two by the Y of the BERRY)
15. Brush Wink of Stella over the Blackberry Bliss letters to give them a little shimmer!
