Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Peach Pie	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Natural Hues Textured Specialty Paper	card front, top panel	3" x 3 ¾"
Splash of Sparkles Specialty Paper	card front, bottom panel	2" x 3 ¾"
Basic White	die-cut animals	4" x 2 ½"
Basic White	greeting	scrap

Instructions

1. Fold the Peach Pie cardstock on the score line to create the card base.
2. Stamp the doggies image from the Cutest Crew stamp set onto the 4" x 2 ½" piece of Basic White cardstock, with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
3. Use the Watercolour Pencils to colour animals. Use a Blender Pen to gently blend the colours on the coloured animals.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut the stamped doggies image using the coordinating Cutest Crew die.
5. Stamp a greeting onto a scrap piece of Basic White cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.

6. Attach the Natural Hues Textured Specialty Paper to the top centre portion of the card base.
7. Attach the stripe Splash of Sparkles Specialty Designer Series Paper to the bottom centre of the card base.
8. Use scissors to cut out the greeting from the Basic White cardstock.
9. Attach the die-cut dog to the centre of your card base (covering the seam where the two specialty papers meet) with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Attach the cut-out greeting above the dogs and slightly to the right-hand side of the card.
11. Attach a few of the clear Epoxy Shapes to the front of the card.
