Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Secret Sea	card base	8 1/2" x 5 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
Basic White	leaves	5 1/2" x 3 1/2"
Cloud Cover	greeting	3 1/4" x 3/4"
Twine	bow	6"

Instructions

1. Fold the Secret Sea cardstock on the score line to create the card base.
2. Lightly rub the VersaMark ink pad around the edges of the Cloud Cover cardstock.
3. Sprinkle Silver embossing Powder over the Cloud Cover cardstock. Shake off the excess powder. Heat the powder with the Heat Tool until it melts and becomes shiny.
4. Stamp the "thank you" from the Greenery Lane stamp set on the Cloud Cover cardstock (stamp it a little right of centre) with Secret Sea ink,
5. Attach Washi Tape to the 5 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Basic White cardstock.
6. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the leaf branches using the Greenery Lane Dies.
7. Attach one of the die-cut leaf branches to the back of the Cloud Cover greeting strip (to the left of the greeting).
8. Attach the other two die-cut pieces to the front of the Cloud Cover greeting (on the left side). Be sure to fan them out a little so you can see each one.
9. Attach the Cloud Cover strip with die-cut pieces to the card base in the top ⅓ of the card.
10. Stamp the small flower from the Greenery Lane stamp set on the card base (three above the die-cut pieces and two below) with Secret See ink.
11. Tie a small bow with the White Baker's Twine from the Essentials Bakers Twine.
12. Attach the bow where the stems of the die-cut pieces meet with a small dot of Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue
