## **Encircled in Warmth Chocolate Gift Box**

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## Supplies:

**Stamp Sets:** Encircled in Warmth (156449)

**Inks:** Versamark Ink (102283)

**Paper:** Heartwarming Hugs Designer Series Paper (153492), Basic White Cardstock (159276)

**Other:** Mini Paper Pumpkin Box (153069), Neutrals Stampin' Write Markers (147158), Brights Stampin' Write Markers (147157), Real Red 3/8" Sheer Ribbon (153535), Bone Folder (102300), Ice Cream Cone Builder Punch (154241), Label me Fancy Punch (151297), Paper Trimmer (152392), Tear & Tape Adhesive (154031), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

## Measurements Box:

- DSP 5 1/4" x 9 1/2" (score at 1", 4 3/4", 5 3/4")
- Basic White Tag: 4" x 1"
- Ribbon: 32"

## Measurements for Chocolate Wrappers:

- 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

## Measurements Bow:

- DSP: 1/2" x 3 1/4" (6 pieces)
- DSP: 1/2" x 2 3/4" (6 pieces)
- DSP: 1/2" x 2 (1 piece)

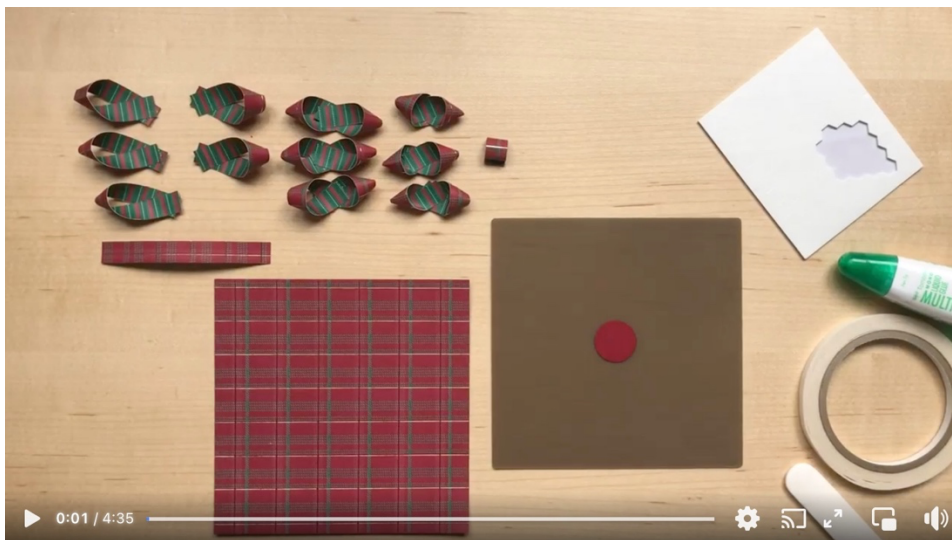
## Instructions

1. Fold the Mini Paper Pumpkin box up according to package directions. There are 10 boxes so you can make lots of gift!
2. Wrap the chocolates by adding a small piece of Tear & Tape to an edge of the square pieces of Designer Series Paper. I used "Merci" chocolates as I liked that there was a bunch of small chocolates that I could use. Wrap the paper tightly around the chocolate and seal! Use a variety of papers from the same package of paper.
3. Score the large piece of Designer Series Paper as listed above. This is for the outside of the box.
4. Attach some Tear & Tape to the front and back of the box (including the front flap). Attach the scored Designer Series Paper to cover the box.
5. Create the tag by inking up the stamp with the Real Red marker and then Mossy Meadow marker. Be sure to "huff" on the stamp before stamping in on the Basic White cardstock.

6. To get the curve and the scallop on each end of the tags use the two punches. In order to get the ends of the cardstock punched, you need to slide the cardstock into the middle of the punch as pictured.



7. Thread the ribbon thru the tag and then wrap the tag and the ribbon around the box.
8. To create the bow, use the measurements above and watch this video from Stampin' Up! I used the Ice Cream punch as the "circle" piece.

9. Attach the bow to the front of the box with more Tear & Tape.
