

Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Real Red	card base	8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
Basic White	Inside of card	5-1/4" x 4"
Basic White	circle	scrap
Traditions of Christmas Specialty Designer Series Paper	left side	5-1/4" x 2 1/2"
Traditions of Christmas Specialty Designer Series Paper	right side	5-1/4" x 1-3/4"
Traditions of Christmas Specialty Designer Series Paper	on hinge strap	4" x 1-1/4"
Real Red	circle	scrap



Instructions

- 1. Cut a 1-1/2" strip (this piece will be the hinge flap) from the right side of the Real Red card base. Your card now measures 7"x 5-1/2".
- 2. Score your hinge flap strip at 1-1/4" and crease well with a Bone Folder.
- 3. Add adhesive to the smaller end of the scored section on the hinge flap and attach it to the inside on the larger side of your card base.
- **4.** Add the 5-1/4" x 4" piece of Basic White to the inside of your card (will cover the smaller end of your hinge flap).
- **5.** Attach the 5-1/4" x 2-1/2" piece of Traditions of Christmas DSP to the outside front left-hand side of the card.
- **6.** Attach the 5-1/4" x 1-3/4" x piece of Traditions of Christmas DSP to the inside right-hand side of the Basic White layer.
- 7. Attach the 4" x 1-1/4" piece of Traditions of Christmas DSP to the front of the hinge flap.



- 8. Punch out a Circle Punch from the scrap piece of Real Red cardstock using the 2" Circle Punch.
- 9. Stamp the greeting on the scrap piece of Basic White cardstock with Real Red ink.
- **10.** Use the 1-7/8" Circle Punch to punch out the sentiment.
- 11. Adhere the two circles together.
- 12. Attach the circles to the front and top of the hinge flap with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 13. Add the Flower Accents to the front of the card. On this card there is a flower on each of the red flowers (x8) on the left (top) part of the card and one on circle with the greeting.
- 14. If desired, adhere some more Traditions of Christmas DSP to the envelope flap.
