

Instructions

Tag WITHOUT the Ribbon Swash

- 1. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the label shape from the Designer Series Paper with Label Me Grateful Dies.
- 2. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the same shape from the Basic White cardstock.

 TIP: You can cut both these papers at the same time.
- 3. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the curvy banner label from the Basic White cardstock using the Traditional Labels Dies.
- 4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the leaf sprigs from the Glimmer Paper using the Label Me Grateful dies. The sample shows discontinued Shy Shamrock glimmer paper, but you can use the green Glimmer Paper from the Peaceful Garden Glimmer Paper as a great substitute.
- 5. Stamp the greeting on the die-cut curvy banner label with Shaded Spruce ink.
- 6. Stamp the "To: and From:" onto die-cut Basic White label with Cherry Cobbler ink.
- 7. Stamp the pine sprig from the Delicate Pines stamps on the right side of the Basic White label with Shaded Spruce ink.
- 8. Attach the two labels together so the DSP is showing on one side and the To/From is showing on the Basic White side.
- 9. Attach the glimmer sprigs to the front left and bottom right of the front of the tag (on the DSP) with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 10. Attach the greeting banner to the centre of the front of the tag with Stampin' Dimensionals. label and centre it on the front of the tag.
- 11. Add two Cherry Cobbler Faceted Snowflakes to either end of the greeting.
- 12. Use the 1/8" hole punch to punch the right-hand side of the tag. TIP: turn over the tag to do this so you don't make the hole over the 'To'.

13. Fold the Baker's Twine in half and create a knot in the cut ends. Thread the cut /knot end through the hole and loop through the folded end of the twine.

Tag WITH the Ribbon Swash





- 1. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the label shape from the Designer Series Paper with Label Me Grateful Dies.
- 2. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the same shape from the Basic White cardstock.

 TIP: You can cut both these papers at the same time.
- 3. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the curvy banner label from the Basic White cardstock using the Traditional Labels Dies.
- 4. Cut one banner label from Basic White.
- 5. Stamp the greeting on the die-cut curvy banner label with Cherry Cobbler ink.
- 6. Stamp the "To: and From:" onto die-cut Basic White label with Cherry Cobbler ink.

- 7. Stamp the two pine sprig from the Delicate Pines stamps onto the bottom of the Basic White label with Shaded Spruce ink.
- 8. Add a Mini Glue Dot to one end of the ribbon. Glue it to the back of the DSP at the top left. (see photo). TIP: it will be glued to the side of the DSP you don't want to see from the front of the

tag).

- 9. Glue the two labels together so the DSP is showing on one side and the To/From is showing on the Basic White side and the ribbon end is sandwiched in between (the rest of the ribbon should not be sandwiched in between the two labels).
- 10. Add a Mini Glue dot to the bottom right of the DSP label (the side you want to be showing) and adhere the ribbon so it has a 'wave' at the top and extends below the bottom right of the tag.
- 11. Attach the greeting label to the front and centre of the tag.
- 12. Add two Shaded Spruce Faceted Snowflakes to the tag at either end of the greeting.
- 13. Use the 1/8" hole punch to punch the right-hand side of the tag. TIP: turn over the tag to do this so you don't make the hole over the 'To'.
- 14. Fold the Baker's Twine in half and create a knot in the cut ends. Thread the cut /knot end through the hole and loop through the folded end of the twine.



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
