# **Ornamental Christmas Gift Bag**



### Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Basic White/Basic Black	bag bases	10 ½" x 6, scored as per template below
Modern Christmas Designer Series Paper	top of bag	12" x 1 ½"
Basic White	die-cut tree	3" x 2 ½"
Basic Black	greeting	2" x 3/8"
Gold Foil	die-cut stars	1" x 1"
Ribbon		10" (2 pieces)
Bakers's Twine		8"





### Instructions

- 1. Place the Basic White/Basic Black cardstock on the Paper Trimmer, with the longest edge at the top. Score at 4", 5", 9", and 10". This wraps around to create the sides of the gift bag.
- 2. Turn the Basic White/Basic Black cardstock so the shortest edge is at the top of the Paper Trimmer and score at 1". This forms the base of the gift bag.
- 3. Use scissors along the scored lines along the bottom edge to create flaps (see template).
- 4. Fold along the bag's scored lines.
- 5. Construct the gift bag by first adhering along the long side.
- 6. Fold over the flaps on the bottom and attach together to create the bag's base.
- 7. Wrap the Modern Christmas Designer Series Paper around the top edge of the gift bag and attach it.
- 8. Punch four holes at the top of the gift bag with the small Hole Punch, two on the front and two on the back.
- 9. Thread one piece of Gold Striped Mesh Ribbon through the holes at the front, tie knots at each end, and secure it inside the gift bag. Repeat on the back of the gift bag using the second piece of ribbon.
- 10. Stamp the tree onto the 3" x 2 ½" piece of Basic White cardstock with VersaMark ink
- 11. Sprinkle Gold Embossing Powder over the stamped tree image. Shake off the excess (and funnel excess back into the jar) and heat set with the Heat Tool.





- 12. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut the tree with the matching dies.
- 13. Ink only the "peace & joy" and stamp onto the 2" x 3/8" piece of Basic Black cardstock with VersaMark ink.
- 14. Sprinkle White Embossing Powder over the stamped greeting. Shake off the excess (and funnel it back into the jar) and heat-set with the Heat Tool.
- 15. Attach the greeting to the die-cut tree with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 16. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out two stars from the Gold Foil paper.
- 17. Attach the gold foil stars to the tree with Mini Glue Dots.
- 18. Punch a hole at the top of the tree.
- 19. Thread the Black & White & Gold Baker's Twine through the hole and tie the tree tag onto the gift bag handle.
