
Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Darling Duckling	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Real Red	first layer, four pieces	1 1/8" squares
Basic White	second layer, four pieces	$3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, stamped then cut into $1\frac{3}{4}$ "
		squares
Basic White	circle, die-cut	2 1/4"
Real Red	greeting	4 ½" x ¾"
Basic White	popcorn box	scrap
Basic Black	eyeglass	scrap

Instructions

- 1. Fold the Darling Duckling cardstock on the score line to form the card base.
- 2. Stamp a piece of 3 ½" Basic White square randomly with the popcorn image with Darling Duckling ink.
- 3. Attach the stamped Basic White square and pop with Memento Black ink. Cut into 4 pieces.
- 4. Stamp the word "pop" with Tuxedo Black Memento Black ink in between the popcorn images.
- 5. Cut the stamped Basic White cardstock into four pieces (1 ¾" squares).
- 6. Attach each square to the Real Red squares, then attach them to the card.
- 7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut the 2 1/4" circle using the Spotlight on Nature Die.
- 8. Attach the die-cut circle to the front right-hand side of the card, centred between the two squares.

- 9. Use tape or washi tape to cover the popcorn and the feet on the popcorn bucket stamp. Ink the stamp with Real Red ink, then remove the tape and use markers to colour directly onto the stamp. Use Crushed Curry Stampin' Write marker for the popcorn and the Basic Black Stampin' marker (for the feet)
- 10. "Huff" on the stamp to re-moisten, then stamp it on the scrap piece of Basic White cardstock.
- 11. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the popcorn bucket using the coordinating die.
- 12. Stamp the greeting on Real Red cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
- 13. Trim the end of the greeting and attach it to the middle of the circle.
- 14. Attach the die-cut popcorn bucket over top of the end of the greeting with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 15. Colour the clear Resin Dots with the Dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends marker and let them dry.
- 16. Attach the coloured Resin Dots to the circle.
- 17. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut the glasses with the die using the Basic Black cardstock.
- 18. Add some glue from the Fine-Tip Glue Pen on top of the glasses and let dry for at least an hour, depending on how thick of a layer you add. (I added a fairly thick layer since I like the 3-D effect). Once dry, add the glasses to the card.
