Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Old Olive	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
Basic Black	card front, embossed	5" x 3 ¾"
Pecan Pie	banners & pumpkin stems	4" x 3 ¾"
Basic White	pumpkins	4" x 3 ¼"
Old Olive	leaf vines & leaves	3" x 2 ½"
Pecan Pie	mat	3 ⅜" x ⅝"
Basic Black	greeting	3 ¼" x ½"
Thread	bow	approx. 9"-12"

Instructions

1. Fold the Old Olive cardstock on the score line to form the card base.
2. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, emboss the Basic Black cardstock with the Gathering Leaves Embossing Folder.
3. Attach the embossed Basic Black cardstock to the card base.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a banner from the Pecan Pie cardstock using the eleventh most largest Party Banner Dies.
5. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a smaller banner from the Pecan Pie cardstock using the next smallest size to create an outline banner as well as a banner.
6. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the large and small stems from the remaining Pecan Pie cardstock using the Beautiful Pumpkins Dies. If there isn't enough cardstock left, then cut the stems from the middle of the full banner so it can be hidden.

7. Attach the Banner outline to the card front.
8. Attach inside Banner with Stampin Dimensionals, on an angle inside the Banner outline.
9. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out some vines from the Old Olive cardstock using the Beautiful Pumpkins Dies.
10. Stamp the large and small pumpkins with Pumpkin Pie Ink on the 4" x 3 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock. For the first filled-in stamp, stamp it on the scrap paper first and then on the cardstock. Stamp the detailed stamp directly in the ink pad and then over the top of the stamped image.
11. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the pumpkins using the coordinating dies.
12. Use a Blending Brush to add some Crumb Cake ink to the stems of the pumpkins.
13. Attach the stems to the pumpkins.
14. Tie the Old Olive Linen twine into a bow and attach it to the top of the banner.
15. Attach the largest pumpkin to the middle of the full banner with Stampin' Dimensionals.
16. Attach the smallest pumpkin to the bottom right of the largest pumpkin with Stampin Dimensionals.
17. Attach the vines to the pumpkins with Stampin' Dimensionals
18. Stamp the greeting with VersaMark ink on the Basic Black cardstock. Sprinkle Gold Embossing Powder over top of the greeting and shake off the excess. Heat set with the Heat Tool.
19. Attach the embossed greeting to the small piece of Pecan Pie cardstock.
20. Attach the greeting strip to the bottom of the front of the card, on an angle, with Stampin' Dimensionals.
21. Add three Streaked Dots around the banner.
