Measurements

Basic White Thick	card base	8 1/2" x 5 1/2", scored at 4 1/4" and 1 1/4"
Floral Charm Designer Series Paper	first layer	5 1/4" x 2 3/4"
Floral Charm Designer Series Paper	second layer	5 1/4" x 1"
Basic White	third and fourth layer, embossed	5 1/2" x 4 1/4"
Mossy Meadow	leaves	3" x 2"
Basic White	flower and leaves	2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
Floral Charm Designer Series Paper	envelope flap	6" x 2 1/4"
Thread	bow	12"

Instructions

1. Fold the Basic White Thick cardstock on the score line to form the card base. And fold the second score line back on itself.
2. Add the 5 1/4" x 2 3/4" piece of Floral Charm Designer Series Paper to the wider flap of the card.
3. Add the 5 1/4" x 1" piece of Floral Charm Designer Series Paper to the narrow-folded back strip.
4. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut two rectangles from the 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock using the third and fourth smallest Textured Notes Dies.
5. Stamp the greeting on the smaller of the two rectangles using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
6. Attach the stamped rectangle to the larger rectangle using Stampin' Dimensionals.

7. Attach the rectangles to the card front but only add adhesive on the left side of the rectangle so that you don't stick your card closed.
8. Stamp the smaller flower image on a 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" piece of Basic White with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
9. Colour in the image with the Stampin' Blends markers. Colour the flower centre with Dark Lemon Lolly, the petals with Light Berry Burst and Light & Dark Fresh Freesia and the leaves with Light & Dark Old Olive.
10. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the flower with the coordinating die.
11. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die-cut the smaller leaf from Mossy Meadow card stock.
12. Attach the Mossy Meadow die-cut to the front rectangle.
13. Add a bit of adhesive to the back of the flower die-cut and add the twine in several loops.
14. Attach the die-cut flower and leaves to the rectangle and over top of the Mossy Meadow leaves with Stampin' Dimensionals.
15. Stamp the flower image a couple of times in the lower right inside corner of the card with Berry Burst ink.
16. Add three Shimmer dots around the main image.
17. Attach the 6" x 2 ¼" piece of Designer Series Paper to the flap of an envelope. Use scissors to trim off any excess paper around the flap.
