Measurements

Item	Part of Project	Measurements
Pretty in Pink	card base	8 ½" x 5 ½"
Basic White	first layer, greeting	5 ¼" x 4"
Lovely Garden Designer Series Paper	second layer	3 ⅞" x 3 ⅞"
Basic White	hexagon	scrap
Garden Green	leaves	scrap
Basic White	flowers	scrap
Ribbon	Bow	9"

Instructions

1. Fold the Pretty in Pink cardstock on the score line to form the card base.
2. Stamp the greeting at the bottom of the 5 ¼" x 4" piece of Basic White cardstock with Melon Mambo ink.
3. Attach the Lovely Garden Designer Series Paper to the top of the same piece of Basic White cardstock.
4. Attach the Basic White cardstock to the front of the card base.
5. Stamp a flower image on a scrap piece of Basic White cardstock with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
6. Use the Thankful Garden Decorative Masks and add Melon Mambo ink to the flower petals with a Blending Brush (you do not need to colour the leaves).
7. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the coloured flower using the Thankful Garden Dies.
8. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out the leaves from the Garden Green cardstock scraps using the Thankful Garden Dies.

9. On the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, cut out a hexagon label from the scrap piece of Basic White.
10. Attach the die-cut hexagon to the front of the card, over the Designer Series Paper, with Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Add the flowers to the die-cut hexagon with Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Attach the leaves around the flowers.
13. Tie the ribbon into a bow.
14. Attach the bow with a Mini Glue Dot between the flowers.
