Supplies:

Stamps: Bottled Happiness Photopolymer Stamp Set* (158684)

Ink: Blackberry Bliss (147092)

Paper: Basic White (159276), Blackberry Bliss (133675), Design a Daydream Designer Series Paper (159161)

Accessories: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Paper Trimmer (152392), Vintage Bottle Punch* (158689), Vintage Bottle Shaker Domes (158788), Effervescent Elements (158789), Window Sheets (142314), Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Paper Snips Scissors (103579), Stampin' Seal (152813), Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive (110755), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

Other: box lid or Tupperware container to contain Gems as you pour

Measurements:

- Basic White: 5 ½" x 8 ½", 3 ¼" x 4 ½"
- Basic White: scrap
- Blackberry Bliss: 5 ¼" x 4"
- Designer Series Paper: 5" x 3 ¾"
- Window Sheet: scrap approximately 1 ½" x 3" (to cover back of Shaker Dome)

Instructions:

1. Fold the larger piece of Basic White Cardstock in half to form card base.
2. Adhere Designer Series Paper to Blackberry Bliss Cardstock and adhere to card front. Set aside.
3. Use Vintage Bottle Punch at bottom of remaining piece of Basic White Cardstock, stamp sentiment in Blackberry Bliss at the top.
4. Remove liner from front of Vintage Bottle Shaker Dome and adhere in place behind Basic White Cardstock.
5. Working inside a box lid or Tupperware container, add Effervescent Elements until dome is filled and level. Remove liner from back of Dome and adhere Window Sheet in place to seal dome closed. You can then funnel the loose Effervescent Elements back into the container.
6. Adhere this piece to card front.
7. Working inside a box lid or Tupperware container, add Multipurpose Liquid Glue with the fine tip end at the top of the bottle and down over the sides, add a bit at the bottom of the bottle. Add Effervescent Elements to glue areas, pat in place and allow to dry. You can then funnel the loose Effervescent Elements back into the container.
8. Stamp label in Blackberry Bliss on scrap piece of Basic White Cardstock.
9. Cut out the label with Paper Snips Scissors. Curl the label slightly to fit shape of bottle, adhere in place with Multipurpose Liquid Glue, holding in place for a moment to ensure edges won't lift.
