

## **Ranunculus Romance**

## Supplies:

Stamps: Ranunculus Romance Bundle (157977)

Ink: Gorgeous Grape (147099)

**Paper:** Highland Heather (146986), Basic White (159276), Gorgeous Grape (146987) **Accessories:** Layering Designs Vellum (157764), Highland Heather Stampin' Blends (154887), Foam Adhesive Sheets (152815), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Seal (152813), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)



## Measurements:

- Gorgeous Grape: 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>", scored at 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" (base card)
- Gorgeous Grape: small scrap
- Basic White: 3 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 5" (cut two ~ one for inside)
- Vellum: 3 ¾" x 5"
- Basic White & adhesive sheet: 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" for the ranunculus blossom
- Highland Heather: 4" x 5 1/4" plus small scrap

## Instructions:

- 1. Fold the Gorgeous Grape cardstock in half to form the card base.
- 2. Using the Highland Heather Blend, gently scribble the back of the vellum using the side of the brush tip.
- 3. Adhere to one of the Basic White layers using six Mini Glue Dots on the corners and the middle of each side. I roll the dots between my fingers to decrease the size a little before applying them.
- 4. Stamp the blossom and the receipt on the other Basic White for the inside of the card.
- 5. Stamp the blossom again on the Basic White scrap and adhere it to the foam adhesive sheet. Die cut the blossom.
- 6. Die cut the leaf in Heather and the filigree in Grape.
- 7. Assemble the card as pictured.
