



## Flowering Tulips

### Supplies:

**Stamps:** Flowering Tulips (1576720)

**Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Poppy Parade (147050), Mossy Meadow (147111)

**Paper:** Thick Basic White (159229), Poppy Parade (119793), Basic White (159276)

**Accessories:** Stitched So Sweetly Dies (151690), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper (157670), Blender Pens (102845), Classic Matte Dots (158146), Stampin' Seal (152813), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Paper Trimmer (152392)



## Measurements:

- Thick Basic White: 4 ¼" x 11" score at 5 ½" for card base
- Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper Basic White: 4" x 5 ¼"
- Poppy Parade: 3 ⅛" x 4 ¼"
- Basic White: 3" x 4 ¼"

## Instructions:

1. Fold Thick Basic cardstock at score line for card base.
2. Attach Flowering Fields Designer Series Paper and Poppy Parade cardstock to card front with Stampin' Seal.
3. Use the largest of the dies from the Stitched So Sweetly Dies to die-cut the shape from the Basic White piece.
4. Stamp sentiment in Memento ink as shown.
5. Stamp stem and leaves in Mossy Meadow ink, then use the Blender Pen to fill in the leaves so there is no white showing.
6. Stamp large tulip on stem with Poppy Parade ink, then repeatedly stamp all of the smaller tulip shapes over the top by stamping off once prior to stamping. This gives a variegated look to the flower.
7. Attach The stamped image to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Attach 3 of the Classic Matted Dots to the card front.
